
GERMAN LANGUAGE TRAINING

The purpose of this service is to assist the candidate and explain the different options of bridging the German Language Training courses and the related fees for any given candidate to select from.

It also prepares and qualifies the potential candidate(s) for the minimum German Language level required for job placement in Germany in the same domain according to the German authorities' requirements and standards

WHY LEARN GERMAN

German Language is the language of Mozart, Bach, and Beethoven; and grasp the competitive business edge that German will give you globally.

People that speak German as their native language exceed any other language in Europe. Germany is also the most populous country in Europe. It is one of the most popular languages taught worldwide.

Germany has the third-largest economy in the world, and they have been the leaders for exports for 5 consecutive years

There are many reasons why you should learn the German language – below we highlight some of those reasons:

1. German is the fifth most widely taught language worldwide, after Spanish.
2. German remains the language with the most native speakers in Europe, with around 100 million native speakers, after Russian, with 120 million native speakers.
3. German is the official language in Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, and Liechtenstein.
4. There are 35 dialects of the German language.
5. Germans usually live in a diversified environment and communities
6. Germans travel and interact with many and different nations around the world; so their culture and heritage become an important part of the world's culture and heritage.
7. The German economy ranks number one in Europe and number four worldwide. Its economy is comparable to that of all the world's Spanish-speaking countries combined
8. Germany's contribution in the field of knowledge is priceless, German-speaking authors/scientists have earned 13 Nobel prizes in literature and 30 Nobel prizes in physics.
9. It is an essential language for academia. With world-class Universities, Germany is becoming an attraction in the international student community for undergraduate and post-graduate courses.
10. Germany is the world's second-largest exporter.
11. Germany is home to numerous international corporations
12. German is the gateway to a world-class higher education

GERMAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM STRUCTURE

All European languages have been categorised into several performance levels. Based on “I can ...” the CREF levels define certain communication abilities and outputs to be attained by the student. These are as follows:

A1 | Beginner At the A1 CEFR level, a language learner can:

- Understand and use basic expressions to satisfy concrete needs.
- Introduce themselves and ask others questions about personal details.
- Interact simply if the other person speaks slowly and clearly.

A2 | Elementary At the A2 CEFR level, a language learner can:

- Understand frequently used expressions in most intermediate areas such as shopping, family, employment, etc.
- Complete tasks that are routine and involve a direct exchange of information.
- Describe matters of immediate need in simple terms

B1 | Intermediate At the B1 CEFR level, a language learner can:

- Understand points regarding family, work, school or leisure-related topics.
- Deal with most travel situations in areas where the language is spoken.
- Create simple texts on topics of personal interest.
- Describe experiences, events, dreams, and ambitions, as well as opinions or plans in brief

GERMAN LANGUAGE TRAINING PROGRAM

Prior to enrolling in the German Language Training Program, the candidate should have:

1. Passed successfully the Application Evaluation phase
2. Passed the CV assessment phase
3. Registered officially with ASDAM
4. Cleared the required CV assessment and registration Fees
5. Submitted the required documents.

At this point, the candidate is ready to enroll into the German Language training program and select one of the below options:

OPTION1: GERMAN AGENCY's ONLINE LANGUAGE TRAINING PROGRAM

German Language training program provided by our German Agency online from Germany. ASDAM and the local Agent will manage the candidate's registration and enrollment and provide the course details and schedule. This program is of the following specifications

PROGRAM SPECIFICATIONS

1. The training program will be implemented online by a certified and approved Native German Language teacher live from Germany appointed by our German agency.
2. The candidate will be assessed at the end of each level and tested at the end of the required level for the designated profession (A2 or B1).
3. One Hundred (100) calendar hours (60 min/hour) of online Language Training for each of the required levels. The payment is made directly to our German Agency one level at the time.
4. ASDAM's local Agent arranges the testing hall (facility) for a group of 15-20 candidates according to the requirements, which will be provided by ASDAM.
5. The appointed German Language examiner will supervise the language test by flying to the candidates' home country after the arrangement is already set.
6. The test is a paper-based provided by the provider **ECL** (European Consortium for the Certificate of Attainment in Modern Languages).
7. Our German Agency will issue the participation certificates of attended levels for the candidate, provided that s/he passes the assessment carried out by the program tutor.
8. Our German Agency will issue the test certificate for the successful candidate(s).
9. In case of test failing, the candidate is allowed to repeat the test as many times as necessary until the candidate passes the test, provided that the candidate pays the test session fees.

PROGRAM TUITION FEES

Selecting this option, the candidate pays the local agent or directly the German Agency the following tuition fees:

1. The amount of One Thousand US Dollars (\$1,000) for 100 hours (\$10 per hour) being the German Language online training program for A1-level.
2. The same amount as above must be paid prior to the enrollment in each of the required levels (A2 and B1).
3. The amount of One Hundred Fifty US Dollars (\$150) being the German Language examiner fee.
4. The amount of One Hundred Fifty US Dollars (\$150) being the B1-Level language test certificate fee for the successful candidate.

PROGRAM SERVICES

The fees of this option include the following services:

1. Registration, administration, processing, follow up job offer processing.
2. One Hundred (100) online calendar hours (60 min/hour) of German Languages Training for each of the required levels.
3. An accredited and certified German Language trainer/tutor for the required language levels to lead the program online from Germany.
4. Participation Certificate for the candidate for each completed level.
5. Certificate of successful completion for those who pass the A2 or B1-level ECL test.
6. Digital German Language training material (books).
7. Online platform access code.
8. German Language examination/assessment.
9. German Language Examiner/assessor.
10. Selection of Job or School or Institute
11. Job Search
12. Processing the candidate's documents/qualifications with a potential employer
13. Preparing a job offer for the candidate.

OPTION2: QHUK GERMAN LANGUAGE TRAINING PROGRAM

This course is delivered online through Teams platform via **QHUK's** specialised German Native Language Teacher. This training course is of the following specifications:

PROGRAM SPECIFICATIONS

1. The German Language training program will be implemented online by a certified and approved live Native German Language tutor/teacher.
2. The Program will be implemented through Teams platform.
3. The program is formed of Sixty (60) hours of online German Language Training for each of the required levels.
4. The system will provide an assessment and exist evaluation test for the candidates at the end of each level.
5. QHUK will provide a participation and attendance certificate for each successful candidate.
6. The successful candidate, at the end of the required level such as A2 or B1 needs to book a test appointment with an approved and recognized testing center such as **Goethe Institute** in the country of residence and pays the required test session fees.
7. The testing center issues the A2 or B1-level test certificate for the successful candidate(s).
8. In case of test failing, the candidate is eligible to repeat the test as many times as necessary until the candidate passes the test, provided that the candidate bears the test session fees.

PROGRAM TUITION FEES

Selecting this option (Option 2), the candidate pays **QHUK** the following fees:

1. The amount of Three Hundred US Dollars (\$300) being the German Language online training program for each of the required levels.
2. The test fees session for each of the required tests are paid by the candidate.

PROGRAM SERVICES

Selecting this option, the fees include the following services:

1. Registration, administration, processing, follow up and job offer processing.
2. Sixty (60) online hours of German Languages Training for each of the required levels (A1, A2 and B1)
3. An approved and certified online Native German Language trainer for the required levels
4. Participation Certificate and exist evaluation assessment at the end of each level for each candidate.
5. Digital German Language training material.
6. Online platform access code.
7. Processing the candidate's documents and/or qualifications with ASDAM.

OPTION3: DELEGATE MANAGED GERMAN LANGUAGE TRAINING PROGRAM

This option allows the candidate to select and choose a suitable and reasonable Language training center in the country of residence in order to join the German Language training for the required level(s).

The candidate should always coordinate closely with the local agent for all requirements along the different phases of the program and adhere to the timeline agreed and set.

PROGRAM SPECIFICATIONS

1. The German Language training program will be implemented either online or in class by an approved live German Language tutor/teacher.
2. The program duration must be of minimum Sixty (60) hours of German Language Training for each of the required levels.
3. The program provider should provide an assessment and exit evaluation test for the program candidates at the end of each level.
4. The program provider should provide a participation and attendance certificate for each successful candidate at the end of each required level.
5. The program provider, at the end of the required level such as A2 or B1 needs to book a test appointment with an approved and recognized testing center such as **Goethe Institute** in the country of residence for the successful candidate who pays the required test session fees.
6. The testing center issues the required level test certificate for the successful candidate
7. In case the candidate fails the test, s/he is eligible to repeat the test as many times as necessary until the candidate passes the test, provided that the candidate bears the test session fees.

PROGRAM TUITION FEES

The candidate should follow the program provider policy in the country of residence. The fees include:

1. Registration, administration, processing, follow up and job offer processing fees.
2. The German Language Training Program tuition fees for all the levels taught.
3. The tested level certificate fee.
4. Any additional course fee involved.

PROGRAM SERVICES

The selected German language training center should provide the enrolled candidate with the following services:

1. Minimum of sixty (60) hours of German Language Training for each of the required levels whether online or in class..
2. An approved and certified German Language trainer for the required language levels to instruct the program.
3. Approved and Proper German Language training material for each level.
4. Processing the candidate's documents with ASDAM's local agent.
5. An assessment and exist evaluation test for the candidates at the end of each level.
6. A participation and attendance certificate for each successful candidate at the end of each level.
7. Book an official test appointment with an approved and recognized testing center or institute such as **Goethe Institute** in the country of residence and pays the required test session fee.
